Previous Minutes		
1. A previous meeting minutes from 9 th September were tabled and accepted.		
Project Update / New Business		
1. Andrew Lawry gave a presentation to the meeting (attached) that contained general information on zinc, copper and lead, Woodlawn history and future plans. The presentation also provided an update on current activities and achievements.		
2. The Mining Operations Plan (MOP) was approved since the last meeting as was Heron's first Annual Environmental Management Report (AEMR). Mr Meng queried whether an AEMR meeting will be held. Initial feedback from some of the stakeholders indicated a meeting will not be required.		
3. It was noted that a modification to the project approval requires consultation with the CCC and that the minutes will reflect this. The project modification was tabled at the last meeting and involves relocation of the mine portal from Hickory's paddock to the western side of the pit. The proposed location is highly disturbed and will mainly affect Veolia. Heron are conducting a revised water assessment and noise and dust evaluations.		
General Business / Other matters		
1. The company queried how the CCC disseminate information to the broader community. It was advised this is achieved through the Tarago and District Progress Association Inc (TADPAI) and through the Tarago Time. It was recommended to Heron to contact and provide routine updates as Veolia do.		AL
Community complaints and company response		
1. Two complaints received since the last meeting:		
2. A community member reported noise from the plane conducting an aerial survey (6km from Woodlawn). The caller did not complain but more wanted to know how long the survey would take.		
3. A community member (4km from Woodlawn) reported a dead ewe in a dam. This was thought to have been caused by the aerial survey plane. The person was compensated for the loss and the issue satisfactorily resolved.
